Our History

The PNANC, Inc. has been in existence for over four decades.

- 1961 - A group of pioneering Filipino nurses in San Francisco formed the Filipino Nurses Association (FNA). This group was the nucleus of the organization.
- 1981 - FNA became PNA of Northern California, Inc., a California non-profit benefit corporation.
- 1987 - The organization changed its name to Philippine Nurses Association of Northern California, Inc. (PNANC, Inc.)
- 1993 - Sponsored the First International Nursing Symposium held in Manila, Philippines.
1996 - Recognized as a 501(c)(3) non-profit public benefit corporation.
- 1997 - PNANC and PNAA co-sponsored the First Western Regional Conference.
- 1998 - Provided support & assistance in organizing the first Filipino Nursing Student Organization (FNOSA).
- 2000 - Pete Calixto, past President of PNANC became the President of PNAA.
- 2007 - Araceli Antonio, Past President of PNANC became the first elected President of the PNAA Foundation.
