- Demonstrate superior record of academic achievement with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
- Participate in extra-curricular activities or community activities; such as, hospital volunteer, community service, school-related activities.
- Two letters of recommendations (one must be from a clinical instructor and your current instructor).
- Leadership ability or potential that has been demonstrated both within and outside the clinical setting.
