Philippine Nurses Association of Northern California Student Scholarship

The Philippine Nurses Association of Northern California, Inc. (PNANC) promotes fellowship and unity among Filipino nurses. It provides activities that foster their professional development.

PNANC offers two scholarship awards to Filipino-American nursing students currently in an accredited school of nursing.

There are two categories of scholarship awards: undergraduate and graduate.

The amount for each awardee is \$1,000.

The scholarship application is available on the PNANC website, pnanorthcal.org. **The deadline is May 1, 2024.**

Requirements:

- Filipino ancestry
- Undergraduate: The student must be enrolled in the 2nd year or higher in an accredited nursing program
- Graduate: The student must be enrolled in the 1st year or higher of the Master's or Doctorate program in an accredited nursing program
- Cumulative GPA 3.0 or higher
- 2 letters of recommendation

Undergraduate:

- One letter from a clinical instructor
- Employer whom you have worked with for more than 2 years or another nursing instructor
- Transcript: Official Transcript from an accredited nursing program
- If an official transcript does not arrive before the deadline, you may submit an unofficial transcript signed by a nursing instructor (including title, printed name, signature, and phone number) to verify your grades. However, an official transcript must still be submitted and arrive within one week after the deadline to be considered.
- Submit a passport picture and agree for PNANC to announce the awardee's accomplishments publicly.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the PNANC Spring Conference on May 24, 2024.

Graduate:

- One letter from the nursing instructor in your current program
- Letter from a community organization verifying your community service or certificate of participation
- Transcript: Official Transcript from an accredited nursing program
- If an official transcript does not arrive before the deadline, you may submit an unofficial transcript signed by a nursing instructor (including title, printed name, signature, and phone number) to verify your grades. An official transcript must still be submitted and arrive within 1 week after the deadline to be considered.
- Submit a passport picture and agree for PNANC to announce the awardee's accomplishments publicly.
